The Treatment Centre is situated at the end of Junction Place, off Great Junction Street and may also be accessed from Bonnington Road, next to the Victoria Swim Centre.

The Centre is run by North East Edinburgh Local Health Partnership, which is based on the third floor of the building.

Please report to the Main Reception Desk on the ground floor.

The Leith Community Treatment Centre has 4 floors, with lift transfer to all floors which can be accessed from the car park on Bonnington Road.

Access to the Centre by Ambulance and on foot is from Junction Place. The car park is accessed from Bonnington Road, next to the Swim Centre.

Car parking is limited and there are 2 disabled spaces. If you have particular parking and access issues please contact reception on 0131 536 6225 before your appointment so that suitable arrangements can be made for you.

There is unrestricted on street parking nearby, please allow time to park when attending the centre.

Great Junction Street is well served by Buses. Bus numbers 7, 10, 14, 16, 21, 22, 34 all stop near to Junction Place, the 36 travels along Bonnington Road and the 12 and 49 stop at the foot of Leith Walk.
